What is Office Based Anesthesia & Sedation?

It is a variety of medication options specifically chosen and administered to the needs of each patient and experience while remaining in your doctor's inspected and permitted office.

Deep Sedation provides unconsciousness where the patient does not see, hear or feel anything unpleasant or unwanted during their dental care. These anesthetic medications are administered through an IV line.

General Anesthesia (GA) provides a state of unconsciousness through the use of medications for amnesia, analgesia, sedation, and muscle paralysis. These medications are administered through an IV line. Our specific anesthetic is referred to as a **Total Intravenous Anesthetic (TIVA)**.
